

May 5, 2014
Texas Township Supervisors

The Supervisors of Texas Township held their Bi-monthly meeting on May 5, 2014. Present were Supervisors Don Doney, Allan Wickle, Paul Sprague, Secretary Joann Hancock and Zoning Officer Jeff DeYoung. See attached list for guests present. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Chairman Doney.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and on a motion by Supervisor Sprague and seconded by Supervisor Wickle the minutes were approved as read.

The secretary then presented outstanding invoices for the period and on a motion by Supervisor Wickle and seconded by Supervisor Sprague the bills were ordered paid.

Georgette brought up that the ad for the Clean Up day did not have a begin time. Secretary to contact the paper for the correction.

Zoning Officer - no permits in the past 2 weeks. Sent letters to property owners about debris so they could take advantage of the Clean Up day.

Read a correspondence from Lake Region Chamber regarding the letter of permission from the Supervisors for them to contact the fire companies. Supervisor Sprague motioned to send the letter and Al seconded the motion. Al mentioned that events like this need a permit to use.

Roadmasters- not anything much to report. Need to spend money for grading and rolling on Bucks Cove Road. Paul spoke of new money available for Dirt and Gravel Roads but a Supervisor needs to attend a course first, by Penn DOT, before you can apply for these monies. Bucks Cove is our only dirt road.

Supervisor Doney spoke with someone from the DEP that wants to inspect the Flood Control in White Mills. He explained that more work needed to be done such as drain the pond and do some repairs before the inspection which is scheduled for May 23rd.....maybe if weather permits the work could be done by then.

On Fords Road, does Joseph still own that property. Apparently a new driveway was put in and there is a pipe, that is clogged and rain water can not flow thru pipe. Zoning Officer to send letter and give owners 10-15 days notice to repair clogged pipe.

Georgette mentions a property, with trailer on it that has permanent electric to it. Believe owners live in Florida, but family members use the trailer. They never obtained any permits for trailer, or driveway. Not a permanent resident, no permits, not up to code, no taxes being paid.

Trees across from Rusty Palmers is Residential property in Commercial zone and the township has no authority over the trees being removed.

Concerns of emergency vehicles crossing the bridge with a weight limit of 3 tons.some emergency vehicles weigh more than the 3 ton limit. Don expanded that we were told we could put concrete barriers on the bridge as a temporary fix and that they weigh more than the bridge limit alone. Eric brought up that there are easements that allow some over the limit to cross such bridges.....such as fuel, delivery and emergency vehicles. Concerns were raised about the liability to the township if the bridge should collapse. The other bridge on Willow Avenue was brought up as an example.....it toke State Police 3 days to close that bridge.

With no further business a motion made to adjourn meeting by Supervisor Sprague and Seconded by Supervisor Wickle at 8:11.

The Supervisors of Texas Township held their Bi-monthly meeting on August 4, 2014. Present were Supervisors Don Doney, Allan Wickle, Paul Sprague, Secretary Joann Hancock. See attached list for guests present. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Chairman Doney.

Minutes of the conditional Use Hearing regarding Private Use Kennel were read. Application was read, accepted and signed for approval of the Private Kennel for Paul & Deb Brooks. Motion by Supervisor Sprague and seconded by Supervisor Wickle.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and on a motion by Supervisor Wickle and seconded by Supervisor Sprague the minutes were approved as read.

Supervisors were questioned on when the line painting would be done for Old Willow Road. Supervisor Wickle approached by Mr. Odell from Prompton who has cinders for Texas Township. Supervisors Wickle will pick up. Supervisor Doney would like to replace using cinders this winter with stone. This process will be more expensive but we will use less and the clean up in spring time will be at a minimum.

Supervisor Doney read a letter received from Stephen Knash, Engineer, stating that after inspection, Canal Street should be posted for a 10 TON limit. Supervisor Doney also announced nearing the end of preparation to submit the 2nd Grant Request for the Bridge repairs.

Cal Teeple has agreed to stay on the Zoning Hearing Board for a term of 2 years and on a motion by Supervisor Doney and seconded by Supervisor Wickle, motion approved.

Ordinance to Adopt a Planning Committee was read, accepted and signed.

Com Center contacted Supervisor Doney about fire on Old State Road at the home of Mr. Decker. Mr. Decker was not only burning un-approved materials in the burning barrel but left the fire un-attended. supervisor Doney suggested that the Zoning Officer should pay Mr. Decker a visit and possibly fine him. Carol Santos suggested that a copy of the burning ordinance also be delivered because many people have not seen nor read the burning ordinance. Also mentioned by Supervisor Doney was requesting proof of proper disposal of the items dumped on Mr. Decker's property.

Mr. Teeple contacted Supervisor Doney again regarding the large tree on Pond Road that has large overhanging branches that are close to coming down on his property during any storm. The tree is believed to be on Sundam-Dorflinger property that borders the Hancock residence on Elizabeth Street. It was recommended that Tom Dein, the caretaker, of Dorflinger be contacted.
