**Texas Township Supervisors**

The Supervisors of Texas Township held their Bi-monthly meeting on October 20, 2014. Present were Supervisors Don Doney, Allan Wickle, Paul Sprague. Secretary Joann Hancock and Zoning Officer Jeffrey DeYoung. See attached list for guests present. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Chairman Doney.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and on a motion by Supervisor Wickle and seconded by Supervisor Sprague the minutes were approved as read.

Grace Anderson of the Pennsylvtuckie Grill property wants to put up another building on the property for an indoor shooting range. Architect Tim Ackman was in attendance to explain the "preliminary drawings" that they presented to the Supervisors. One issue mentioned was the required number of parking spaces needed for the additional building. Ms. Anderson explained that for her and the architect to move to the next level of creating the blueprints, which is very expensive, that she would like some kind of assurance that the building permit will be issued when the time comes, which they hope to start before the frost is in the ground. Supervisors and members of the Planning Committee, Ric Southerton and Clyde Kreider, both of the Texas Township Planning Committee were in attendance, explained that the plan would need to be considered at the next Planning Committee meeting scheduled for Monday October 27th and possibly need to go for review to the Wayne County Planning Commission. Concern raised by Supervisor Doney regarding the Easement for going across the river located very near the property.
