

October 6, 2014
Texas Township Supervisors

The Supervisors of Texas Township held their Bi-monthly meeting on October 6, 2014. Present were Supervisors Don Doney, Allan Wickle, Paul Sprague. Secretary Joann Hancock and Zoning Officer Jeffrey DeYoung. See attached list for guests present. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Chairman Doney.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and on a motion by Supervisor Sprague and seconded by Supervisor Wickle the minutes were approved as read.

The secretary then presented outstanding invoices for the period and on a motion by Supervisor Wickle and seconded by Supervisor Sprague the bills were ordered paid.

Ed Thomas asked on the progress of the line painting leading to Walmart. Still no reply from Walmart and Supervisor Doney explained that the cost would be approximately \$2500 to the township. Jeff to visit the manager at Walmart again and talk with Lee Krause.

Mr. Spry mentioned the C&C Gutter property on Route 6 and Jeff DeYoung Zoning Officer visited the property twice and the owner was not available. Jeff will continue to try and reach him. Mr. Spry also asked how unregistered cars are you allowed, because there is a property on Charles Street that has at least 3, only 1 is allowed. Jeff will also check this out.

Supervisor Doney was called again by the fire company concerning a controlled burn but did not contact the COM Center.

Supervisor Wickle mentioned that is time to inspect the trailer park. He and Jeff will arrange.

Supervisors proposed and passed motion to pay the new Planning Committee \$35 for each meeting attended and \$50 for the Planning Committee Secretary. Supervisor Wickle approved and Supervisor Sprague seconded. Also Matt Meagher was appointed to a 2-year term on the Planning Committee. The maximum is a 4 year term for any member, Ric Southern will need to be a 4-year term. As each term runs out they will go to a 4-year term, and that rotation is good for each. They will need to have another reorganizational meeting for 2015.

Supervisor Doney proposed to reject the recent bids received for the road work on Lakeside Drive and Bear Swamp till Spring 2015 due to the uncertain weather conditions that could delay the completion of work in 2014. Motion made by Supervisor Sprague and seconded by Supervisor Wickle. A letter will be sent to Wayco who was awarded the bid, but they were unable to guarantee completion due to possible weather conditions.

Zoning Officer Addressed

Violations went out to Ms. Anderson re: sign issues and to Mr. Decker waiting for responds to both. Chris Martin went to Ford's road, spoke to son in law of folks who own the 5th wheel. They agreed to dig up sewer line and cap it. the camper will need to be removed. It is illegal to be set up as permanent dwelling in Texas Township. Doney suggested that Mr. Decker speak to our solicitor.
